Sam just turned 6 in October. He still goes to Kindergarden & when he isn't playing soccer or riding his bike, he loves to help his Dad...

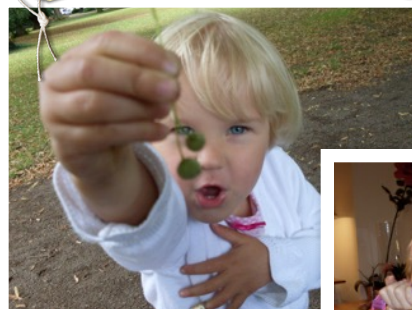
Whether it's cleaning the car, loading the church van, or "fixing stuff", he's always game. He is a fun kid and full of life!
